Following is the condition of the heart patient Nguyen Dinh Thoi

Nguyen Dinh Thoi, born in 2001. Thoi is currently living with grandparents in Dien Hai Commune, Phong Dien District, Thua Thien Hue Province. He was born with a congenital heart disease, but his family could not afford to take him to the hospital for examination. Recently, when his health deteriorated, they took him to the hospital. However, after a period of hospitalization, they still cannot get any money to pay for Thoi's surgery. From young until now, Thoi lives with her grandparents because her mother is mentally ill and has left the family for a long time. His father also left to go to the South after that, having no contact with his family. The life of the grandparents and Thoi depended on grandfather's work in catching fish on the river because his grandmother was blind and could not work. Occasionally, Thoi's uncle helped him and his grandparents a little to live. The grandparents are over 70 years old this year, so he could not work much more to support his grandchildren. Because of the very urgent time for Thoi's surgery, OGCDL did not have time to visit her family to confirm his situation. However, OGCDL contacted the local authority where Thoi and grandparents are living to get more information. Through the local government, all information provided by Thoi's grandfather is completely correct.

Thoi and his grandparents at the hospital sometimes receive a few hundred thousand VND helped by their roommates. Thoi's grandfather did not know where to rely when the hospital announced that his family had prepared 40 million VND (minus the estimated insurance payment) to pay for Thoi's surgery. Therefore, he was introduced to OGCDL to ask for help because with the current situation, his family did not have any money to pay for Thoi's surgery. Before that situation, the Hue Central Hospital also ask an for help from other donor with 30 million VND. They hope that EOCRO will support him with lacked 10 million VND.
